“the 2025 Latin American GRSS & ISPRS Remote Sensing (LAGIRS 2025) conference”

The 2025 Latin American GRSS & ISPRS Remote Sensing (LAGIRS 2025) conference is held on November 10-13, 2025. LAGIRS is meant to be a preeminent event in remote sensing in Latin America and shall provide an ideal forum for obtaining up-to-date information about the latest developments, exchanging ideas, identifying future trends and networking with the Latin American and international geoscience and remote sensing community.

Along with the conference, a special issue of the IEEE Journal of Selected Topics in Applied Earth Observations and Remote Sensing (J-STARS) has been planned, open to the Authors of all papers presented during the conference.

Please note that papers submitted to this J-STARS special issue should NOT be the same as the LAGIRSS conference papers. A 2 to 3 times longer paper is typically expected, with a more detailed presentation of the work, enhanced techniques and approaches, including additional data sets and comparisons in an enhanced experimental section.

In the cover letter, please provide the corresponding paper title for LAGIRS2025. If this information is not provided, the paper will be considered as a regular submission.

Format

All submissions will be peer reviewed according to the IEEE Geoscience and Remote Sensing Society guidelines. Submitted articles should not have been published or be under review elsewhere. Submit your manuscript on <http://mc.manuscriptcentral.com/jstars>, using the Manuscript Central interface and select the “LAGIRS2025” special issue manuscript type. All submissions must be formatted using the IEEE standard format (double column, single spaced). Please note that since Jan. 1, 2025, IEEE J-STARS, as a fully open-access journal, charges a flat publication fee \$1,800 per paper.
